**SERVICEPERSONS OF COMMERCIALWEIGHING AND MEASURING DEVICES
LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION**

Under Section 39-9-65 ET SEQ of the South Carolina Code of Laws, the South Carolina Department of Agriculture registers servicepersons of commercial weighing and measuring devices. A Registered Serviceperson has the authority to remove an official rejection tag or mark placed on a weighing or measuring device by the authority of the Commissioner; place in service, until such time as an official examination can be made, a weighing or measuring device that has been officially rejected; and place in service, until such time as an official examination can be made, a new or used weighing or measuring device. The Registered Serviceperson is responsible for installing, repairing, and adjusting devices such that the devices are adjusted as closely as practicable to zero error and that the device meets all the specifications, tolerances, and other technical requirements in National Institute of Standards and Technology Handbook 44.

All Serviceperson licenses expire each year on August 31st. Please return your license application, a fee of \$25.00 and proof of calibration of your test standards to the Department of Agriculture.
