Quality average to attractive, few plain. Demand moderate to good. Demand continues especially good for grazing type cattle, despite the extreme dry conditions across much of the state. Cold front pushed thru the state over the weekend bringing icy conditions to the east. This along with the bitter cold limited livestock movement. Feeder cattle supply included 58 percent Steers, 1 percent Dairy Steers, 39 percent Heifers, and 2 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 70 percent.
