Compared to last week: Feeder steers 600-800 lbs 5.00-9.00 higher, heavier weights mostly steady to 1.00 higher. Feeder heifers 2.00-6.00 higher. Steer and heifer calves 5.00-10.00 higher. Demand good to very good, especially so for thinner fleshed calves headed to graze wheat pasture. Active bidding throughout the sale from a full crowd. Quality average to attractive with more than a few long-weaned, home-raised offerings sold. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (59% Steers, 40% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 53%.								
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows and bulls not well tested due to last week's very light test, but a much lighter tone was noted. Demand good. A total of 252 cows and bulls sold with 70% going to packers. The estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Lean cows 124.80; Boners 126.45; Breakers 121.90; Light weight cows 111.00; Bulls 157.80. Supply included: 71% Feeder Cattle; 27% Slaughter Cattle (92% Cows, 8% Bulls); 2% Replacement Cattle (54% Bred Cows, 46% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder Cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
