Compared to last week: Feeder steers steady to 2.00 lower, except 600-650 lbs 1.00 higher. Feeder heifers 1.00-5.00 lower. Steer and heifer calves steady to 4.00 higher on a limited test. Demand good. Quality average to attractive. Heavy rains continue to fall across the state causing major flooding in some areas. Cattle futures also posting big losses over the past several days and live cattle prices took a hit once again. All of this lead to limited receipts. Supply included: 100% Feeder cattle (59% Steers, 38% heifers, 3% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 70%. Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 3.00-5.00 higher. Slaughter bulls too lightly tested with a higher undertone noted. Quality average to attractive. Demand good to very good. A total of 193 cows and bulls sold with 54 percent going to slaughter. Estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Leans 127.00; Boners 124.80; Breakers 120.64; Light Weight Cows 119.68; Bulls 155.05.
