Compared to last week: Feeder steers 600-700 lbs 2.00-3.00 lower, heavier weights mostly steady. Feeder heifers 2.00 lower with exception of 700-800 lbs. 1.00 higher. Steer calves 500-550 lbs 3.00 lower, other weights not tested. Heifer calves lightly tested with a lower undertone noted. Quality plain to attractive. Trade active. Huge fed kills by the packers lately showing feedlot becoming more current. Unseasonably cool, wet weather slowing beef demand and grilling season. The abundance of fed beef in May is largest in years and corn planting is closing in on records for the least amount of acres planted for this time in May. Supply included 100% Feeder Cattle. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 81%.									
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows steady to 3.00 lower on a light test. Slaughter bulls too lightly tested with a lower undertone noted. Demand moderate. Receipts lighter this week due to severe weather and flooding. A total of 192 cows and bulls sold with 49 percent going to slaughter.
