Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 4.00 higher with instances of 6.00 higher. Steer and heifer calves not well tested. Demand good. Quality plain to average. More seasonable like weather has finally arrived and temps are expected to reach into the low 100's. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (51% Steers, 0% Dairy Steers, 47% Heifers, 2% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 80%.							
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows sold 3.00 higher on Boner cows. Breakers and lean cows too lightly tested last week for an accurate trend. Slaughter bulls too lightly tested but a lower undertone noted. A total of 383 cows and bulls sold with 51 percent going to packers. The estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Lean cows 122.04; Boners 123.46; Breakers 125.85; Light Weight cows 118.85; Bulls 150.96. Supply included: 35% Slaughter cattle (95% Cows, 5% bulls); 65% Replacement Cattle (56% Bred Cows, 44% Cow-Calf Pairs).
