Quality average to attractive. Consistent, blistering heat impacting pasture conditions and this is encouraging producers to sell. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (50% Steers, 48% Heifers, 2% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 500 lbs was 70%.								
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows steady to 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls sold mostly steady. Demand good to very good.								
A total of 412 cows and bulls sold with 45 percent going to packers.
