Demand light. Extreme heat has swept across the trade area bringing triple digit temps. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (59% Steers, 1% Dairy Steers, 38% Heifers, 2% Bulls). Compared to last week: Slaughter cows mostly steady with instances of 5.00 higher on breaker cows due to higher quality this week. Slaughter bulls lightly tested with a higher undertone noted. Demand good. Quality average to attractive with more than a few exceptional breaker cows on offer. A total of 203 cows and bulls sold with 78 percent going to packers. The estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Lean cows 129.59; Boners 127.06; Breakers 127.78; Light Weight cows 122.55; Bulls 160.03.
