Compared to last week: Feeder steers steady to 2.00 higher. Feeder heifers trading unevenly steady. Steer calves 1.00-3.00 lower and heifer calves steady to 2.00 lower on calves over 450 lbs. Lighter weight calves not well tested, but a higher undertone was noted. Demand good, trade active. Quality average to attractive with many lots of uniform, thinner fleshed yearlings on offer. Several fresh weaned bawling calves offered today as well. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (64% Steers, 0% Dairy Steers, 31% Heifers, 0% Cows, 5% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 68%.									
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 8.00-10.00 lower. Slaughter bulls lightly tested with a sharply lower undertone noted. Demand moderate. Quality plain to average. A total of 502 cows and bulls with 49 percent going to packers. The estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Lean cows 106.26; Boners 106.02; Breakers 106.58; Light Weight Cows 112.29; Bulls 135.81. Supply included: 59% Slaughter Cattle (92% Cows, 8% Bulls); 41% Replacement Cattle (97% Bred Cows, 2% Bred Heifers, 1% Bulls).
