Heifer calves over 500 lbs 2.00-6.00 lower. Demand moderate to good. Demand good for heifers over 600 lbs. Quality average and improved from last week. Early winter weather sent grass pastures to dormancy and this along with a weekend of nice weather increased supply for the week. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (56% Steers, 41% Heifers, 2% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 48%.									
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows steady to 3.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand moderate to good. Best demand for fleshier cows weighing over 1400 lbs. Demand moderate to good for replacement cows. Typical cull sale with several old thin cows on offer. Many of these headed to feed. A total of 605 cows and bulls sold with 34 percent going to packers. The estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Lean cows 101.55; Boners 101.45; Breakers 98.70; few light weight cows 97.65. Bulls 131.80. Supply included: 58% Slaughter Cattle (91% Cows, 9% Bulls); 42% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows).
