Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary							
Compared to last week: Feeder steers 600-850 lbs. 1.00-3.00 lower. 850-1000 lbs. firm to sharply higher with very few sales from last week to compare to. 600-700 lb. feeder heifers likewise brought 1.00-3.00 lower, with heavier cattle unevenly steady on a very light test. Steer and heifer calves steady to 2.00 lower. Demand moderate to good, especially good for 850-1000 lb steers. Trade active and quality plain to attractive. CME Cattle Futures settled down hard today and traded quite volatile all last week. Feedyards becoming more current with carcass weights down a few pounds over the week. Feeder cattle supply included 54 percent Steers, 42 percent Heifers, and 3 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 43 percent. Slaughter bulls 2.00-4.00 lower. Packer demand light to moderate. Cattle movement continues in high numbers again this week as producers look to transition their herds as we move into winter time. A total of 549 cows and bulls sold with 37 percent going to packers.
