Heifer calves 450-600 lbs mostly 1.00-5.00 lower, lighter weights not well tested. Demand moderate. Quality plain to average with quite a few fleshier calves on offer. A strong winter storm is expected mid to late week across the trade area. Cash cattle trade ended up trading \$1 higher Friday and CME Cattle Futures settled lower today. Feeder cattle supply included 57 percent Steers, 40 percent Heifers, and 4 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 52 percent.
