Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers 9.00-15.00 lower. Steer and heifer calves were too lightly tested for an accurate trend, however a sharply lower undertone is noted. Demand light. CME Live and Feeder cattle contracts continue to sharply decline causing nervousness within the market. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (65% Steers, 30% Heifers, 5% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 73%.							
Compared to last week: All classes lightly tested. Slaughter cows 2.00-4.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.00 higher. Packer demand good for the light numbers. A total of 82 cows and bulls sold with 49 percent going to packers. The estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Lean cows 134.05; Boners 129.90; Breakers 124.80; Light Weight Cows not well tested. Bulls 157.55. Supply included: 48% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 31% Slaughter Cattle (82% Cows, 18% Bulls); 21% Replacement Cattle (88% Bred Cows, 13% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
