Numbers of heavy weight cattle off graze out wheat continue bug, however this could be the last week of the wheat run. Cattle futures are sharply lower today, following the decline from the end of last week. Moisture levels are good across the state and more rain and thunderstorms are expected to move across the state this week. Supply included 82 percent over 600 lbs; 37 percent heifers. Slaughter cows sold steady. Slaughter bulls mostly steady to 1.00 higher. Packer demand good. Demand moderate to good for replacement cows and very limited pairs.
