Steer calves mostly 4.00 lower on a light test. Heifer calves 4.00-7.00 higher. Demand moderate to good. Quality average to attractive. Weather continues extremely dry and many pulling wheat cattle early. Feeder cattle coming off short wheat in medium to fleshy conditions. Slight chance of moisture for Tuesday but totals expected to be minimal. Feeder cattle supply included 66 percent Steers, 0 percent Dairy Steers, 33 percent Heifers, and 1 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 70 percent.
