Demand good. Quality plain to average. Unseasonably cooler temperatures along with heavy rainfall has hampered livestock movement. Feeder cattle supply included 55 percent Steers, 42 percent Heifers, and 3 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 69 percent. Slaughter cows steady to 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls mostly 1.00 higher. Packer demand good. A total of 214 cows and bulls sold with 40 percent going to packers.
