Compared to last week: All classes of feeder cattle and calves lightly tested. Heavy rainfall continued to fall across much of the state over the weekend and the first cold front of the season pushed thru the state on Sunday. This hampered livestock movement and limiting receipts. Where tested, steers under 800 lbs sold 1.00-3.00 lower, few over 800 lbs firm. Feeder heifers and heifer calves 3.00-6.00 lower. Demand moderate. Quality plain to average. Feeder cattle supply included 54 percent Steers, 43 percent Heifers, and 3 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 47 percent.										
Slaughter cows sold steady to 2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand moderate; moderate to good for the few bred cows. A total of 307 cows and bulls sold with 56 percent going to packers.
