Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary											
Compared to last week's light test: Feeder steers 1.00-4.00 higher. Feeder heifers trading mostly 4.00 higher on limited comparable receipts. Steer and heifer calves had little comparable weight ranges to compare to last week but a sharply higher undertone noted. Demand very good for all classes. Quality average to attractive. Friday's Cattle on Feed report displayed a total of a little over 11 million head which was the highest October total since the report began. Negotiated fat cattle traded steady again Friday allowing the CME Live Cattle Futures to continue to run higher. Feeder cattle supply included 53 percent Steers, 0 percent Dairy Steers, 42 percent Heifers, and 5 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 45 percent.											
Slaughter cows sold unevenly steady. Slaughter bulls 2.00-4.00 lower. Packer demand moderate to good. A total of 649 cows and bulls sold with 52 percent going to packers.
