Feeder heifers 2.00-3.00 higher. Demand moderate to good for feeder cattle. Best demand for those over 800 lbs. Steer calves 1.00-4.00 higher and heifer calves steady to 2.00 higher. Demand moderate to good for calves. Buyers very selective for number of days weaned and 60-75 days didn't seem to be enough. Weather finally turned dry, thus farmers were better able to move cattle to market. More chances of rain are in the forecast by midweek. Quality average to attractive. Feeder cattle supply included 76 percent Steers, 0 percent Dairy Steers, 22 percent Heifers, 0 percent Cows, and 2 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 20 percent. Slaughter cows 3.00-6.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 3.00-4.00 lower. Packer demand light to moderate. Cows coming to market all over the country and packers have all they can handle. Several middle aged and aged cows, open and bred returning to the country. A total of 507 cows and bulls sold with 47 percent going to packers.
