Compared to the last sale on 12-17-2018: Feeder steers sold 2.00-7.00 higher. Steer calves sold mostly steady except 500 lbs 8.00 lower. Feeder heifers steady to 3.00 higher and heifer calves 2.00-3.00 higher. Demand moderate to good. Heavier weight steers continue most popular. Heavy rain and snow has most of the trade area in very muddy conditions and these conditions are discouraging calf buyers from buying at this time. Quality average to attractive. Feeder cattle supply included 62 percent Steers, 36 percent Heifers, and 2 percent Bulls. Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 53 percent.											
Slaughter cows steady to 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.00 higher. Packer demand moderate. Supply included several nice replacement cows from one ranch and these sold to good demand. A total of 906 cows and bulls sold with 43 percent going to packers.
