A strong winter storm moved in over the weekend dumping heavy snows to the north and bringing sharp wind chills locally. This caused many producers to delay shipping. CME Feeder Cattle index down \$3 over last week and some feedyards waiting for pens to harden and dry up a bit before receiving too many more cattle.
