Compared to last week: Feeder steers steady to 4.00 lower. Feeder heifers 1.00-3.00 lower. Steer calves 2.00 lower. Heifer calves mostly steady, instances 2.00 higher. Demand moderate to good. Quality average. More unweaned calves showing up and these selling to limited demand. Hevy rainfall and sharp declines on both the CME Live and Feeder cattle contracts had sellers either unable to get cattle out or were reluctant of the market. Supply included: 100% Feeder cattle (49% Steers, 50% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 72%.							
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows mostly 1.00-5.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady to 1.00 lower. Packer demand mostly moderate. A total of 339 cows and bulls sold with 48% going to slaughter. Estimated dressed cost at the Oklahoma National Stockyards: Leans 123.35; Boners 119.80; Breakers 112.20; Light Weight Cows 118.40; Bulls 152.20. Supply included: 60% Slaughter Cattle; 40% Replacement Cattle.
