Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 76%.								
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows on a very light test sold steady to 4.00 lower. Slaughter bulls on a light test steady to 2.00 lower. Demand moderate. A total of 261 cows and bulls sold with 66 percent going to packers. **Please note, the estimated dressed cost will be suspended until further notice.**
