Light weight (under 500 lbs) steer and heifer calves selling 10.00-15.00 higher. Demand very good for steer calves; moderate for heifers. Quality average to attractive. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (62% Steers, 1% Dairy Steers, 36% Heifers, 0% Cows, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lb was 50%.							
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 1.00-4.00 higher, except Lean cows 2.00-5.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand moderate. A total of 620 cows and bulls sold with 73 percent going to packers. Supply included: 56% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 32% Slaughter Cattle (95% Cows, 5% Bulls; 12% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
