Slaughter cattle prices moved higher on shorter numbers last week this as beef prices continue to improve. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (56% Steers, 43% Heifers, 1% Bulls, 0% Dairy Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 46%.							
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows sold mostly steady. Slaughter bulls 1.00 lower. Packer demand moderate. A total of 394 cows and bulls sold with 66% going to packers. Supply included: 53% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 31% Slaughter Cattle (86% Cows, 14% Bulls); 16% Replacement Cattle (86% Bred Cows, 10% Cow-Calf Pairs, 5% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
