Compared to last sale on 12/14/20: Feeder steers 1.00-4.00 lower. Feeder heifers steady to 3.00 lower. Steer calves steady to 2.00 lower. Heifer calves steady to 3.00 higher. Demand light to moderate as cattle futures traded sharply lower on Monday. Feeder cattle futures lower in response to a higher corn market. Record snowfall hit on New Year's and many wheat fields are extremely muddy or covered in water as a result. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (69% Steers, 31% Heifers, 0% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 68%. Compared to last sale (12/15/20): Slaughter cows sold 1.00-3.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 4.00-5.00 higher. Packer demand good to very good. A total of 316 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent going to packers. Supply included: 58% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 25% Slaughter Cattle (83% Cows, 17% Bulls); 17% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
