**Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary**  
 Compared to last week: Feeder steers steady to 2.00 lower where tested. Steer calves mostly 4.00-8.00 lower. Feeder heifers and heifer calves unevenly steady. Demand moderate. Winter weather moved in with freezing drizzle, creating hazardous travel conditions, especially in the direction of many feedyards. Frigid temps are here to stay for the next 10 days or so. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (64% Steers, 36% Heifers, 0% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 58%.  
 Compared to last week: Slaughter cows mostly steady to 2.00 higher coming off last week's higher market. Slaughter bulls 1.00-2.00 higher. Packer demand good to very good. A total of 195 cows and bulls sold with 30 percent going to packers. Supply included: 60% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 15% Slaughter Cattle (89% Cows, 11% Bulls); 25% Replacement Cattle (50% Bred Cows, 12% Bred Heifers, 38% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
