**Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary**  
 Compared to the last sale two weeks ago: Feeder steers and heifers lightly tested and few sales steady to 2.00 higher. Demand moderate to good for feeder cattle following a week of no sales due to weather. Steer and heifer calves steady in a light test. Demand good for calves. Grain futures continue to push higher cost of gains at the feedyards, however this has yet to effect the demand for feeder cattle. Little to no movement of feeder cattle has helped some. Quality average to attractive. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (61% Steers, 39% Heifers, 0% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 75%.  
 Compared to the last sale (02/09/21): Slaughter cows mostly 1.00-4.00 higher on a light test. Slaughter bulls had too few receipts for an adequate market test. Packer demand good to very good. A total of 181 cows and bulls sold with 49% going to packers. Supply included: 53% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 23% Slaughter Cattle (98% Cows, 2% Bulls); 24% Replacement Cattle (88% Bred Cows, 13% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
