Demand good for all classes as several new buyers in the stands on Monday. Quality average to attractive with several cattle coming off of wheat pasture. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (57% Steers, 1% Dairy Steers, 41% heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 66%.

Compared to last week: Slaughter cows, boner and lean cows sold 2.00-3.00 lower. Breakers cows not tested on very light receipts from last week. Slaughter bulls 2.00-3.00 lower. Packer demand moderate. Supply included: 0% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 81% Slaughter Cattle (82% Cows, 18% Bulls); 19% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
