**Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary**

Compared to last week: Feeder steers 2.00-4.00 higher. Feeder heifers steady to 3.00 higher. Steer calves steady. Heifer calves 3.00-8.00 higher. Demand moderate to good. Quality average to attractive. Cattle futures sharply higher on Monday. Cattle futures have improved following last week's grain reports that caused a sharp increase in grains futures and sharp declines in the cattle. Supply included 100% Feeder Cattle (55% Steers, 44% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 69%.

Compared to last week: Slaughter cows and bulls mostly steady. Packer demand moderate to good. A total of 362 cows and bulls sold with 53 percent going to packers. Supply included: 52% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 25% Slaughter Cattle (85% Cows, 15% Bulls); 23% Replacement Cattle (87% Bred Cows, 8% Bred Heifers, 5% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
