Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady. Steer calves 2.00-4.00 lower. Heifer calves steady. Quality average to attractive. Demand moderate to good. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (56% Steers, 43% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 81%.

Compared to last week: Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Packer demand moderate. A total of 241 cows and bulls sold with 79% going to packers. Supply included: 57% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 34% Slaughter Cattle (85% Cows, 15% Bulls); 9% Replacement Cattle (89% Bred Cows, 11% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
