Midweek winter storm is expected to bring ice and snow to much of the area and this is discouraging buyers. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (61% Steers, 37% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 56%.											
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows and bulls 2.00-4.00 higher. Demand moderate to good. A total of 368 cows and bulls sold with 85 percent going to packers. Supply included: 56% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 36% Slaughter Cattle (95% Cows, 5% Bulls); 9% Replacment Cattle (92% Bred Cows, 8% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
