Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (55% Steers, 1% Dairy Steers, 43% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 63%.											
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 1.00-3.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 1.00-3.00 higher. Demand was moderate to good.
