Compared to two weeks ago: Feeder steers and heifers 3.00-5.00 higher. Steer calves steady to 3.00 lower.									
Heifer calves 1.00-4.00 higher. Demand moderate to good. Quality average to attractive. Most of the region has been impacted by extreme heat and very dry conditions. Areas of extreme drought expanding across the state. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (60% Steers, 38% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 64%.									
Compared to two weeks ago: Slaughter cows 6.00-8.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 10.00 lower. Demand moderate to good. Quality mostly average. The lack of moisture, extreme heat and higher fuel prices are having a major impact on feeding cows across the region. Much of the area is back in the extreme and severe drought conditions once again. Many ranchers are already into feeding hay or having to buy it. Due to the lack of availability or high hay prices ranchers are forced into selling deep into their herds. Supply included: 35% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 59% Slaughter Cattle (94% Cows, 6% Bulls); 6% Replacement Cattle (39% Bred Cows, 61% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
