Outlook continues to show bullish indicators. Slaughter cattle sold higher last week and at 140.00 in the South and 144.00-148.00 in the North. Percent of cattle Monday over 600 lbs was still limited and many of those cattle weighed 600-700 lbs and not very many heavier.
