Compared to two weeks ago: Feeder steers mostly steady. Steer calves 4.00-8.00 lower. Feeder heifers steady to 2.00 higher. Heifer calves unevenly steady. Demand very good for feeder cattle and long weaned calves; moderate for others. Large run Monday despite many farmers busy in the field planting wheat. It feels like October outside, but not talking about the weather. Several un-weaned, bawling calves available. A small stint of fall like weather moved in over the weekend bringing some light moisture to the northwestern part of the state. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (60% Steers, 35% Heifers, 4% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 42%.								Apr	
Compared to last test two weeks ago: Slaughter cows 6.00-8.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 4.00-5.00 lower. Packer demand moderate as large numbers continue to move to market. Supply included: 29% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 52% Slaughter Cattle (94% Cows, 6% Bulls); 18% Replacement Cattle (12% Stock Cows, 73% Bred Cows, 7% Bred Heifers, 8% Cow-Calf Pairs).
