Compared to last week: Feeder steers 1.00 to 3.00 lower. Feeder heifers unevenly steady. Demand moderate to good. Quality mostly average. Steer calves unevenly steady. Heifer calves 2.00 to 4.00 lower. Demand moderate for calves. Some of the region received much needed moisture over the weekend with more in the forecast early in the week. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (52% Steers, 41% Heifers, 7% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 39%.								Oct	78.23	
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows steady to 4.00 lower. Slaughter bulls sold steady on a light test. Demand moderate. Several large drafts of cows included. The drought continues, leaving no choice for the rancher but to sell. Hay supplies are limited or priced high making it not worth it to winter cows. Wheat prospects also very dim with just over 50 percent of the crop planted and with no rain the chances of it making is very low.
