Steer calves 10.00-20.00 higher. Heifers calves steady to 5.00 higher. Demand remains good for all classes. Cattle futures and cash slaughter cattle trade moved sharply higher over the holiday period. Heavy rains also moved through much of western Oklahoma, drastically improving the drought situation. Some areas receiving up to 10 inches for the month of May. Rain continues to show in the forecast. Quality average to attractive. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (51% Steers, 47% Heifers, 2% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 66%.							Dec	81.63
