Compared to last week: Feeder steers very even, but mostly steady. Feeder heifers 2.00-5.00 higher.							Dec	79.60	
Steer and heifers calves 4.00-6.00 lower. Quality not as attractive as last week and plain to average, few attractive. Demand moderate. Buyers a little more selective for kind of condition. Rain continues to move in from the west delaying wheat harvest. Some combines were running over the weekend and some spots in the south western Oklahoma near half done. These rains helping summer pasture and have provided for some doubling stocking of grass. Cattle futures hit a wall late last week, but are back on the move up today. Slaughter cattle and boxed beef continued their upward momentum. Supply included : 100% Feeder Cattle (53% Steers, 45% Heifers, 2% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 61%. Compared to last week : Slaughter cows steady to 2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 1.00 higher. Packer demand moderate. Demand very good for replacment cows.
