Compared yo last week: Feeder steers and feeder heifers steady. Steer calves steady. Heifer calves 2.00-4.00 higher. Demand is very good as some buyers are dipping down in quality to fill orders. Still seeing cattle coming off grass pastures. Quality is average to attractive. Rain showers around the state today and over the weekend with beneficial rains to parts of Northern Oklahoma. Temperatures have also cooled some and are back in the mid nineties. These timely rains are helping to restock some of the depleted hay supplies. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (58% Steers, 40% Heifers, 2% Bulls, 1% Dairy Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 69%.										
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows sold steady to 1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls sold steady on a light test. Demand moderate to good. Supply included: 52% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 42% Slaughter Cattle (93% Cows, 7% Bulls); 6% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
