<b>Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary</b>								
Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers mostly steady but those over 800 lbs not well tested. Weaned steer calves 2.00-3.00 higher; un-weaned or short weaned steers 3.00-6.00 lower. Heifer calves steady to 5.00 lower. Demand good for feeder and long weaned cattle; moderate for others. Cattle futures lower again today despite the light numbers of available feeders. Spectators are pointing to outside influences for reasons to the lower cattle futures on Monday. Quality mostly average. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (62% Steers, 35% Heifers, 3% bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 57%.								
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady to 2.00 higher. Packer demand good. Several nice replacement cows available and these sold to good demand. Supply included: 35% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 50% Slaughter Cattle (92% Cows, 8% Bulls); 14% Replacement Cattle (97% Bred Cows, 3% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
