<b>Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary</b>								
Compared to last week: Feeder cattle remain very lightly tested. Feeder steers 2.00-5.00 lower. Feeder heifers mostly steady. Demand for feeder cattle moderate but quality plain to average. Weaned calves mostly steady. Un-weaned or short-weaned calves 5.00-10.00 lower. As normal of the time of year, many cattle are un-weaned and these selling to limited demand. Cold front moved in over the weekend and area to the north and west woke with a little frost on the pumpkin. Weather to remain dry the rest of the week with the next chance of rain coming just over a week from now. Slaughter cattle prices moved higher last week and cattle futures did a flip and closed the day in the red. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (56% Steers, 39% Heifers, 5% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 51%.								
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows steady to 4.00 lower, least decline on Breaker Cows. Slaughter bulls 4.00-5.00 higher. Packer demand moderate to good. Frost covering much of the state the last two mornings and the fall cows run is on. Several large lots of cull cows available. Supply included: 34% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 51% Slaughter Cattle (95% Cows, 5% bulls); 15% Replacement Cattle (6% Stock cows, 85% Bred Cows, 2% Bred Heifers, 6% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
