Heavier weight and un-weaned or short weaned steer calves and all heifer calves 4.00-8.00 lower. Orders continue to be mainly for steer calves, thus heifer calves selling at a large discount to it's steer mate. Demand good for light weight steer calves, moderate for others. Quality plain thru attractive. Supply included 100% Feeder Cattle (59% Steers, 38% Heifers, 3% Bulls) Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 44%.										
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 2.00-4.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 1.00-2.00 lower. Packer demand light to moderate with several lots of open cows returning to the country. Supply included: 46% feeder cattle (100% steers); 36% Slaughter cattle (90% Cows, 10% Bulls); 19% Replacement cattle (23% Stock Cows, 68% Bred cows, 9% Bred Heifers). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
