Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold mostly steady to weak. Steer and heifer calves traded 2.00-4.00 higher from last week's sharply higher market. Demand good for all classes. Quality plain to average. A winter storm fell across the trade area over the evening bringing heavy snow and rain. Warmer temperatures are in the forecast for the remainder of the week. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (53% Steers, 46% Heifers, 1% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 56%.								
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows and bulls not well tested, however a higher undertone was noted. Demand very good for limited numbers. Supply included: 61% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 30% Slaughter Cattle (87% Cows, 13% Bulls); 10% Replacement Cattle (100% Bred Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
