Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 4.00-6.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 13.00-14.00 higher. Slaughter bull prices continue to make record highs with a bull weighing 2030 lbs and selling for 197.50. Demand very good for all slaughter classes. Demand for replacement cows very good. Supply included: 42% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 38% Slaughter Cattle (84% Cows, 16% Bulls); 19% Replacement Cattle (69% Bred Cows, 31% Cow-Calf Pairs).
