Compared to last week: Feeder steers weak, with instances to 5.00 lower on those over 800 lbs. Feeder heifers 2.00-5.00 higher. Steer and heifer calves steady to 4.00 higher. Demand good. Quality average. The market held together better than most thought despite heat and humidity returning to Oklahoma and cattle futures posting losses of over 2.00. Supply included: 100% Feeder Cattle (53% Steers, 0% Dairy Steers, 42% Heifers, 5% Bulls). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 66%.										
Compared to last week: Slaughter cows 3.00-5.00 lower, except Breakers cows 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 3.00-5.00 lower, however a few very high dressing bulls once again surpassed the previous week's record of 2.00 and sold for 2.03. Packer demand moderate to good. Supply included: 51% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 34% Slaughter cattle (84% Cows, 16% Bulls); 14% Replacement Cattle (89% Bred Cows, 2% Bred Heifers, 9% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
