Feeder heifers steady to 2.00 lower. Steer calves steady to 4.00 lower. Heifer calves mostly steady.							
Demand moderate to good for all classes. Quality mostly average, few attractive. Weather remains very dry but parts of Northwestern Oklahoma is saw some moisture Monday. Unfortunately, much of the state missed out on the rain. This was the last shot of rain for a while and temps expected to reach near 90 in the coming days.							
Slaughter Cattle: Slaughter cows steady to 2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls not well tested. Packer demand moderate. The drought continues and several light fleshed cattle coming to market. Supply included: 44% Feeder Cattle (100% Steers); 34% Slaughter Cattle (97% Cows, 3% Bulls); 23% Replacement Cattle (75% Stock Cows, 24% Bred Cows, 1% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 0%.
