

# ANNUAL INSPECTION FEES

| REGULATION 61-25: RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS

**The annual inspection fee for each permitted retail food establishment must be calculated and paid to the Department by the date indicated on the annual invoice.**

## HOW TO DETERMINE FEE AMOUNT

Fee amount is based on gross food and food product sales for the previous calendar year.

Gross food sales **do not** include:

- Alcohol
- General merchandise

### EXAMPLE 1

*A convenience store that prepares or packages foods, such as hot dogs, pizza, or sandwiches, on-site must pay the annual fee based on the gross sales of those food items.*

*Gross food sales would not include packaged foods provided by another vendor, such as:*

- Chips
- Canned or Bottled Beverages (this does not include fountain drinks)
- Candies
- Sandwiches

### EXAMPLE 2

*A retail food establishment that bottles or cans food or food products (examples: sauces, dressings, or vegetables) for direct sale to the end consumer must pay the annual fee based on the gross sales of the packaged product.*

## ESTABLISHMENTS OFFERING COMPLIMENTARY MEALS

Hotels and other establishments that offer complimentary meals as part of their service should determine their annual fee based on the total cost of food purchased.

The grade sticker posted at the establishment serves as notification to the public that the facility is permitted. Once the fee has been paid, no paper permit/license will be issued. If the sticker is damaged, contact the SCDA Retail Food Safety & Compliance Department at [retailfood@scda.sc.gov](mailto:retailfood@scda.sc.gov) to request a replacement.

Once gross food and food product sales have been determined, use the fee chart to calculate the annual

inspection fee. For example: A retail food establishment had \$725,031.96 in gross food sales for the previous calendar year. Using the chart, the annual fee is \$200.00.

GROSS SALES OF FOOD AND FOOD PRODUCTS	ANNUAL FEE
\$0 – \$250,000	\$100.00
\$250,001 – \$500,000	\$150.00
\$500,001 – \$750,000	\$200.00
\$750,001 – \$1,000,000	\$250.00
\$1,000,001 – \$1,250,000	\$300.00
\$1,250,001 – \$1,500,000	\$350.00
\$1,500,001 – \$1,750,000	\$400.00
\$1,750,001 and above	\$450.00

## LATE PENALTIES

Annual fees paid after the due date indicated on the invoice will be assessed the following penalties:

- 30 to 59 days past due, add \$50.00 to annual fee
- 60 or more days past due, add \$100.00 to annual fee

## REQUESTING ANNUAL FEE EXEMPTION

If the retail food establishment meets the provisions of *Section 8-304.11(A)(c)(iv)*, an exemption from the annual fee may be requested. A letter detailing how the facility meets the exemption criteria may be mailed to: South Carolina Department of Agriculture, Retail Food Safety & Compliance, 350 Ballard Court, West Columbia 29172.

Exemptions are not permanently granted. A new request must be mailed each year to the above address.
