Vendors with industry-related products will receive first priority at these events. Product exclusivity is not guaranteed amongst vendors.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FESTIVALS

1. Applications will **NOT** be accepted without payment.
2. All spaces will be assigned by event personnel without vendors being guaranteed previous or requested locations.
3. Only items stated on application will be allowed for sale. Items sold must meet festival qualifications. All items must be confined to booth space purchased.
4. Vendors must remain in place for the entire festival. Do not arrive late or leave early.
5. Vendors are allowed access to the festival area between the hours of 7 am – 7 pm.
6. Set-up or restocking is permitted before or after festival hours, **not during**.
7. Vendors may not assign or sublet spaces.
8. Booth must be clean at all times. Vendors are responsible for removal of all trash or refuse of any kind from their space during and after the event is over.
9. No smoking in booth spaces.
10. No pets.
11. Products must be top quality. Plant producers/ growers must have plants free of pests and fungi. Producers/growers are held accountable to the standards set forth by Clemson University's Department of Plant Industry.
12. Vendors are responsible for applicable licensing and taxes.
13. Prepared food service vendors must be in compliance with all South Carolina Department of Agriculture retail food laws (Regulation 61-25).
14. Vendors are responsible for the behavior of their employees. All individuals must adhere to the festival rules and regulations.
15. Firearms, explosives, offensive materials, illegal drugs, and alcoholic beverages are not permitted.
16. Vendors must park all vehicles and trailers in designated vendor parking area. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense and will risk being excluded from future festivals.
17. We will not accommodate overnight RV's or campers on market property.
18. Vendors must respect the property of the South Carolina Department of Agriculture along with the property of fellow vendors.
19. All complaints must be in writing and will be reviewed by the South Carolina Department of Agriculture. These forms are available at the information booth.
20. Vendors are cautioned that violations will result in sanctions imposed by event personnel, these sanctions may include exhibitors being excluded from future events and actual removal from the festival.
21. Event personnel reserve the right to make changes, amendments, and additions to these rules and regulations as it is considered necessary for the good of the event.
22. Vendors must remain in place and available for business until the advertised end time of the event on the last day.
